The first day of school for those students following the AA schedule will be Tuesday, September 8, 2020. (Monday, September 7, 2020 Labor Day – No School). The first day of school for the students following the BB schedule will be Thursday, September 10, 2020. Keep in mind the following schedule will be followed until we have an opportunity to revisit updated data and the COVID – 19 mandates, and make reasonable and safe decisions. We anticipate reviewing data at the end of October 2020, or earlier, if we get positive data.

- AA – Monday/Tuesday In-Person
- BB – Thursday/Friday In-Person
- Wednesday – all students are remote learning

Cafeteria Procedures:

- Breakfast/Lunch - Will be served on the In-person days.
- Grab-N-Go - Food will be available on the buses for students to take home on Tuesday and Friday, please remind your children to take food as they get off the bus.

Masks:

- All Faculty/Staff/Students will be required to wear masks and practice the 6 feet social distancing guidelines as per the PA Department of Health and Gov. Wolf. Students can use their own, or the school will provide plastic face shields and disposable masks.

** Although there will be health and safety practices in place, it is imperative that, as parents/guardians, you monitor you child's symptoms on a daily basis to determine if they need to remain home or be tested for COVID – 19. Please check daily prior to school:

- Fever (100.0 or higher)
- Cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
- Diarrhea
- Chills, repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
